Descriptive accounts of sexual assault, molestation and masturbation has no educational or instructional value. It normalizes sexual assault and molestation. In the end of the book, the stepfather forces Naomi's (main character) little brother to tie the boyfriend, Wash, to a tree. Henry violently rapes his underage daughter in front of his son (her brother) and Wash who is tied to the tree. Henry beats the daughter while raping her then coerces the son to shoot Wash. Son hesitates. Henry shoots his daughter in the leg then beats Wash until he falls on top of Naomi. He shoots Wash and the bullet goes through both of them. Son shoots father in the head — book describes pieces of his head hitting the tree behind him.

2. In your opinion, what are the harmful effects upon students that might result from the use of this item?  
There are many examples of sexual act instruction in this book. A step father that molests and rapes the main character. Additionally there is another descriptive sexual relationship with the main characters boyfriend. Overall a significant amount of explicit sex acts and instruction. In addition, a lot bad language.

I see no instructional value or educational value. The storyline itself is an important portrayal of life in the 1930s and the struggles of an interracial relationship, hardships of loss, grief and growing up but the overwhelming sex instruction takes away from that for young readers.

This book contain molestation multiple times and masturbation.
